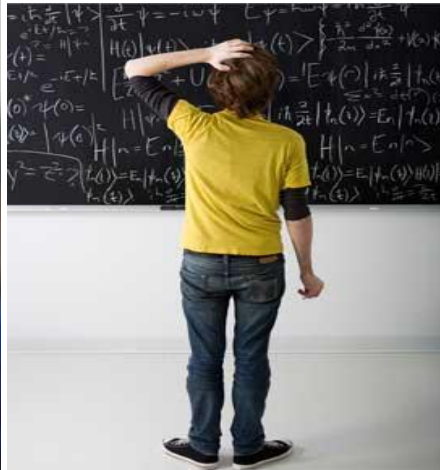


Results of the Tempus and Erasmus Mundus programmes and expectations from the Erasmus+ programme



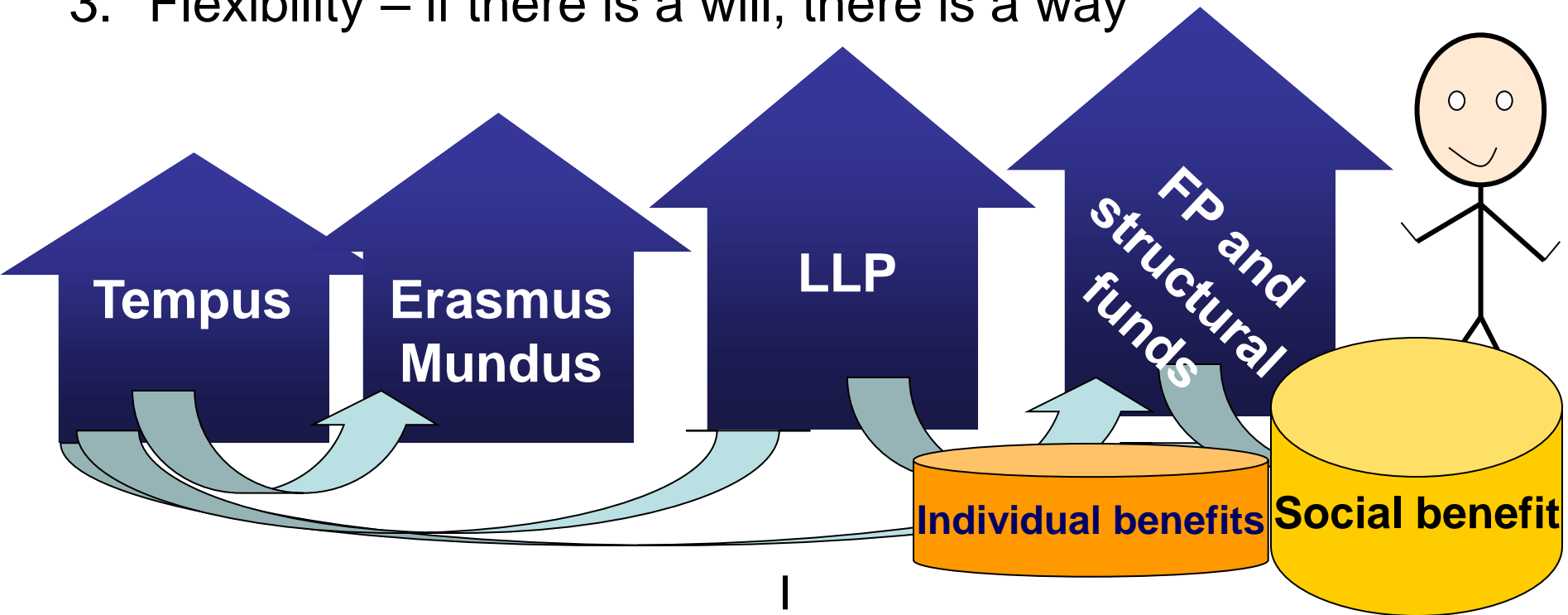
Opportunities available from 2008- 2013

Why is participation in Tempus important?

1. Preparation for participation in other EU programmes
2. Assistance to HE, not a loan
3. Flexibility – if there is a will, there is a way





Tempus – the main results and lessons learnt

- Reinforcing the capacities for project management – half of the projects with Serbia are coordinated by universities and colleges from Serbia**
- New study programmes, many of them are developed in cooperation with the stakeholders**
- More than 30 LLL courses are created and organized for different target groups**
- New institutions and teachers have started to participate in the programme – more than 1200 persons from Serbia have been participating in Tempus**

Very valuable equipment has been purchased by Tempus



The investments have often been combined with HEIs funds

A step forward towards the EU part of the programme – centralized actions of LLP

- Around 60 projects have been funded in 2012 and 2013 calls**
- Consortia include all types of education institutions, enterprises, public authorities, NGOs**
- Expectation: Cooperation to be continued through Strategic partnerships in the future**



Erasmus Mundus=building capacities for mobility and joint programmes

- **Increased mobility opportunities for students and staff**
- **Procedures for organization of the mobility developed at all bigger universities**
- **Joint programmes remain a challenge**
- **Expectation: to increase the bilateral cooperation between the institutions**



Erasmus+ a big opportunity and a challenge

- **Enlarging the cooperation towards other levels of education = towards full participation in the E+**
- **To involve teachers and institutions that did not use the EU education programmes before**
- **To make possible for social partners to have a real role in projects**
- **To prioritize improvement of teaching methodology**
- **To use the Erasmus+ as an instrument for realization of national and institutional strategy**
