Hungarian Higher Education

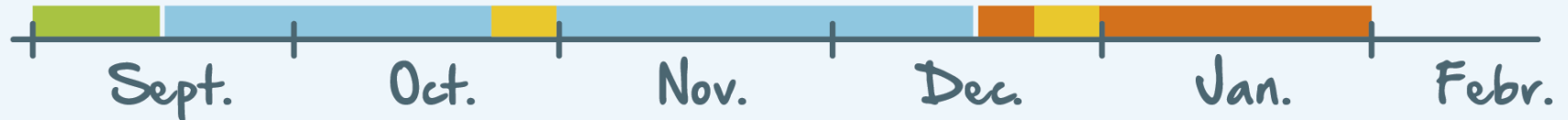
In numbers (as of academic year 2020/2021)

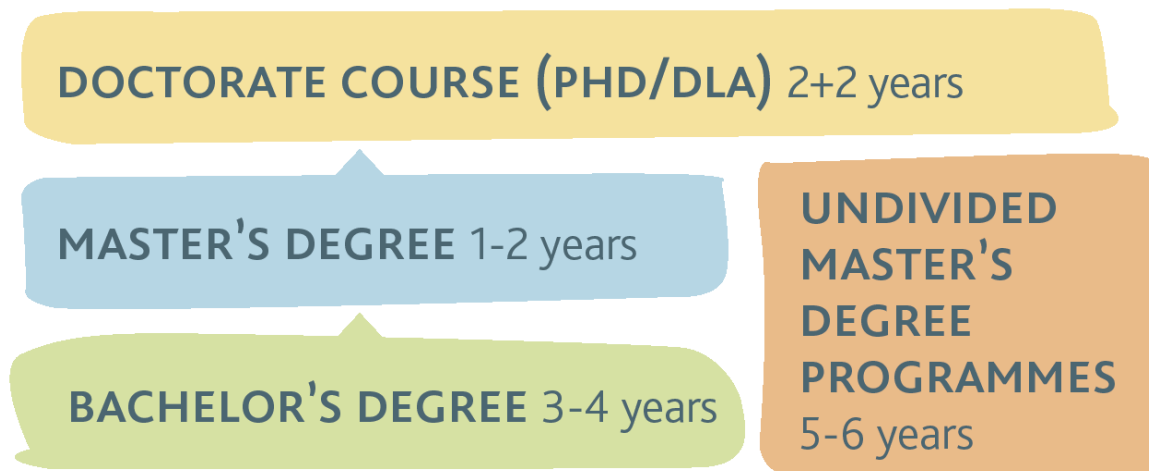

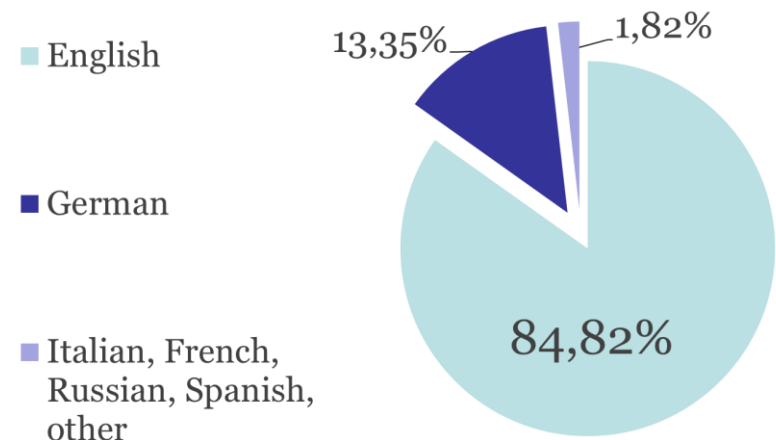

- › language of study programmes offered for international students




