ADMISSION TO BACHELOR PROGRAMMES



Requirements (differs according to programmes, but in general):

- High school leaving certificate
- English language proof (to most programmes: B2 level)

Method of application:

- DreamApply system (apply.elte.hu)
- Entrance exams: for most programs there is an entrance exam and it is organised by the given Faculty
- Letter of acceptance: issued by the Faculty and sent directly to the applicant with a pre-departure checklist (e.g., visa application, deadlines, registration)

Documents:

Online application form
Record of the final two years in secondary school
Secondary school certificate
CV
Motivation letter
Copy of the main pages of the passport
Passport photo
Medical certificate
Language certificate

GOOD TO KNOW



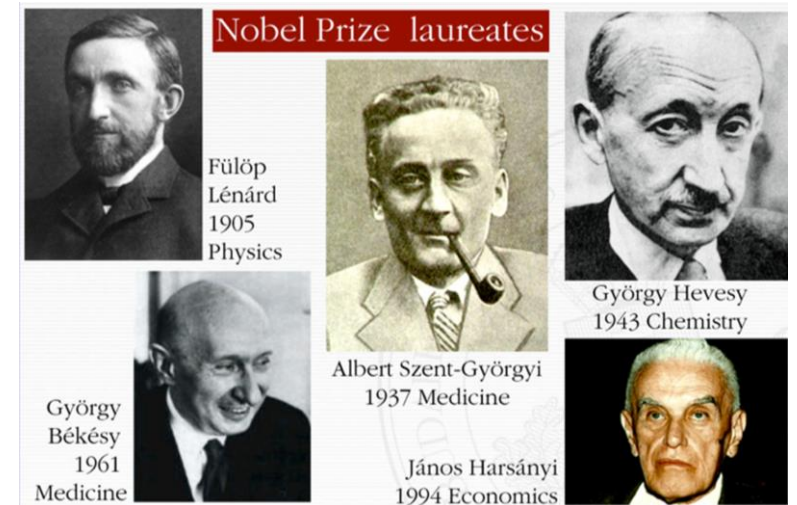
- The most popular university in Hungary: every **4th applicant chose ELTE** in 2020 (www.felvi.hu)
