


CEEPUS IV – New Agreement

- CEEPUS IV signed by all member states
- CEEPUS IV 2025 2032
- Ratified by seven member stats
- Official start is May 2025
- Network application round 2025/26 under CEEPUS IV




Number of Networks





Pledges: Scholarship Months






Key Focus CEEPUS IV Networks

Strengthening CEEPUS IV Networks

- Network = minimum of 5 institutions from 5 CEEPUS countries
- Emphasizing the following points during network selection
 - High quota of participation
 - Integrate young faculty members
 - Involvement of female faculty members / gender balance of faculty members
