

# Annual Summer Schools in Pécs

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### The beginnings of the BCE

- After two years of preparation, the Association of Bioethicists in Central Europe (BCE) was founded in 2009 by Prof. Günter Virt and Prof. Sigrid Müller.
- The 5 members of the founding board (including our rector) are still active leaders, but have expanded as the organisation has grown. 12 countries, 60-100 members
- Annual congress in October: this is where the next year was planned for so long, but now everyone brings a ready program, because there is a weekly collaborative networking.



#### **CEEPUS Bioethics Network**



- The CEEPUS network was established in 2010 with the leadership of Wien (AT), the Episcopal Theological College of Pécs also joined the program, one of our theology students with half Polish origin went to study in Opole (PL).
- In 2011 Prof. Sebastian Moldovan, an Orthodox theologian, came at first to teach from Sibiu (RO).
- We were getting more and more incoming teacher mobilities, so much so by 2016 that the idea of a summer university was born.
- At least 4 summer schools every year in the network, the peak was 8. We take our students to 2 or 3 summer schools.






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### A well-proven structure
