

Hungarian HE internationalisation goals

- > Internationalisation is part of the HE strategy
- ➤ By 2023
 - 20% of the graduates shall have international learning experience (2017: 11%)
 - increasing the number of foreign students to 80 000 by 2030
- > HE modernization, increasing quality of higher education
- > Better services for international students

Hungarian higher education institutions

- > First university established in 1367
- ➤ 64 higher education institution
 - 38 internationally active

- Medical studies (over 30% of all foreign students in Hungary)

HUNGARIAN HIGHER EDUCATION

In numbers (most recent data available)

- > Total number of students (2021): **92.000**
- > Total number of teaching staff (2020): 23.500
- > Total number of international students (2021): 40.000
- Member of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA)
- Bologna system adapted 3 levels
 - Bachelor: mostly 3 years
 - Master: mostly 2 years
 - Doctoral: 2+2 years (from 2017 September) earlier 3 years


Three cycle degree structure (BA/BSc, MA/MSc, PhD)







STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM PROGRAMME

> Scholarship programme for incoming (international) students for full degree or partial studies

Funded by the Hungarian Government

Based on the bilateral agreements between Hungary and the partner countries





STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM PROGRAMME

One application period each year (mid-November – mid-January)

– 2 calls for application:

- Bachelor, Master, One-tier master, non-degree programmes
- Doctoral programmes
- 30 host institutions;600 study programmes in various languages
- Over 88 partner countries





88 countries participate in the Stipendium Hungaricum programme, **22** of them **from Africa**:

North Africa: Algeria, Egypt, Tunisia

South Africa: Angola, South Africa, Namibia, Botswana

East Africa: Eritrea, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Ethiopia

West-Africa: Ghana, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Republic of Liberia, Mali

North-West Africa: Morocco

Central Africa: Rwanda

Islands: São Tomé and Príncipe, Seychelles, Cape Verde

Tuition-free education




- Monthly stipend according to legislation
 - Bachelor/Master: HUF 43 700 (~EUR 120; \$130) /month
 - Doctoral: HUF 140 000 (~EUR 380; \$415) for the first 4 semesters of education and HUF 180 000 (~EUR 485; \$540) for the second 4 semester



- Accommodation
 - In dormitory or
 - a contribution of HUF 40 000 (~EUR 110; \$120)/month



Bilateral State Scholarship Programme

- > Scholarships for students, doctoral students, teachers and researchers;
- > Based on bilateral cooperation agreements;
- ➤ Stipend, accommodation, student card, healthcare, etc. depending on the type of activity;
- Around 30 mobilities per academic year, mainly incoming mobility, outbound mobility needs to be encouraged




