Around 6130 Jean Monnet actions in the field of European studies

Over 90 countries worldwide more than 1000 universities offering Jean Monnet courses

265.000 students per year

Defining European Union studies

"European Union studies comprises the study of Europe in its entirety, with a particular emphasis on the EU dimension, from an internal but also from a global perspective"

Enhancing awareness of the European Union:

- European citizenship and values
- Role of the EU in a globalised world
- Facilitating future engagement as well as **people-to-people dialogue.**
- Vector of **public diplomacy in third countries**, promoting **EU values** and enhancing the visibility of the European Union
- Scope of EU studies may vary so long as an EU angle is explored.

■ Network on internal EU issues - thematic: "Digital transformation inEurope" ONLY: EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme. Max EU-contribution € 1 mio

Network on foreign policy issues - thematic: "Values and Democracy"
 Any HEI in the world
 Exception: organisations from Belarus and Russian Federation are not eligible to participate in these actions.

Max EU-contribution € 1,2 mio





Jean Monnet actions in 2022 – overview Policy Debate

■ Network on external policy issues - thematic: "EU-Africa" <u>Applicant must be:</u> higher education institution (HEI); established in EU Member State or third country associated to the Programme or in the following third countries not associated to the Programme: Sub Saharan Africa countries (Region 9); Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia (Region 3). Max EU-contribution € 1,2 mio

Networks in other fields of education and training

Activities facilitate common understanding on learning methodologies about European Union matters among practitioners working in different contexts, facing different challenges and constraints due the national legislations and the structure of the curricula. ONLY: EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme. Max EU-contribution € 300.000

Deadline for submission of applications	Spring 2023
Evaluation period	April – June 2023
Notification of results to applicants	max. 6 months after submission deadline
Preparation of Grant Agreement/Decision	max. 9 months after submission deadline
