Few good practises – Partnership

- Find personal engagement/commitment on both ends (mutually and meaningful)
- Existing contacts or direct search (Contact seminars could work!)
- Concentrate on a specific form of co-operation or project type
- Develop partnership gradually

Few good practises - Mobility

- Allow more time and attention (in & out)
- Visa and invitation matters (in) Embassy locations
- Bank account and currency issues (in)
- Accommodation (out)
- Personal contact important (in & out)
- Staff mobility as facilitator (in & out)
- Avoid conflict regions (in & out)
- Follow host instructions carefully (out)
