The Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship was established by the Hungarian Government for those who live in a Hungarian diaspora outside of the European Union and wish to study at a Hungarian higher education institution to develop their personal, professional and cultural relations to Hungary.

The programme aims to support the professional advancement of the scholarship holders with high-quality Hungarian higher education while improving their Hungarian language skills and strengthening their Hungarian identity.


After graduation, scholarship holders return to their home country with competitive skills and knowledge that enables them to support their community, preserve Hungarian values and reinforce the relations between the diaspora and Hungary.

The Diaspora Scholarship is also an excellent opportunity to build your professional network and discover everything about the country in a supporting and welcoming student environment.

SPECIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants need to obtain a recommendation letter from a Hungarian diaspora organisation or a Hungarian Diplomatic Representation of the respective country. Applicants also need to submit a motivation letter about their Hungarian roots and what they want to achieve with the scholarship.

STUDY TYPES

BASIC STRUCTURE OF STUDY PROGRAMMES

The programmes follow the three-cycle degree structure in accordance with the European standards. Hungarian higher education institutions use the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

FULL-TIME STUDIES

- > Bachelor, BA/BSc, (undergraduate, 6–8 semesters)
- > Master, MA/MSc (graduate, 2–4 semesters)
- > One-tier master programmes (10–12 semesters)
- > Doctoral studies, PhD/DLA (8 semesters)

NON-DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- > professional and Hungarian language preparatory courses
- > specialisation courses (1–2 semesters)

PART-TIME STUDIES

1–2 semester long exchange studies that are part of the students' degree studies in their sending higher education institution.

PROVISIONS COVERED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP

TUITION-FREE EDUCATION:

exemption from the payment of tuition fees

MEDICAL INSURANCE(S): national health insurance card and supplementary medical insurance

MONTHLY STIPEND (upon request):

- > non-degree, bachelor, master and one-tier master level: HUF 43,700 (ca. EUR 130)
- > doctoral level: HUF 140,000 (ca. EUR 430) for the first 4 semesters and HUF 180,000 (ca. EUR 550) for the second 4 semesters

ACCOMMODATION CONTRIBUTION (upon request):

free dormitory place or a monthly contribution of HUF 40,000 (ca. EUR 120)

STUDENT ID: discount on travel and many services

FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP:

1. Visit www.diasporascholarship.hu to find out more about the scholarship, as well as studying and living in Hungary
2. Check which study fields and levels are available in the scholarship programme; check entry requirements of desired study programmes
3. Contact the local Hungarian diaspora organisation or the Hungarian Diplomatic Representations of your country to receive a recommendation letter
4. Register and upload your documents (including your motivation letter) on the online application system
5. Take the (online) entrance exams at Hungarian universities
6. Wait until the final results released by Tempus Public Foundation
