

## Dear Applicants,

This is a guide in relation with the announcement of the final results of the 2019–2020 application round of the Scholarship Programme for Christian Young People. We have received extremely high number of applications during this year's call, and now it is time to let you know who can start their studies in Hungary from September. After the entrance exams at the Universities, Tempus Public Foundation was responsible for summarizing the individual results and based on this the Minister responsible for higher education has decided about the scholarship holders. The official notification of the applicants about the results has now started.

### There are 3 different types of final results:

- **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED – YES**, now you are a Scholarship Holder. You need to start the administrative procedures by accepting the scholarship in the online application system, and downloading your Letter of Acceptance from the University and your Letter of Award from Tempus Public Foundation that you need for your visa application process.
- **SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONALLY AWARDED** – You are only one step away from the scholarship. You need to upload your missing documents (study or language certificate, or other requested documents) until the deadline 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019, and also accept the scholarship according to the below-mentioned procedure.
- **REJECTED – NO**, in this case, unfortunately you did not receive the scholarship.

### Scholarship Holders need to complete the following steps:

1. Submit the missing documents until **11<sup>th</sup> August 2019** the latest (if needed, see above: Scholarship Conditionally Awarded).
2. YOU HAVE TO ACCEPT YOUR SCHOLARSHIP by clicking on „I accept the scholarship” in the online application system (<https://apply.scyp.hu/>)!
3. Get familiar [with the Rules and Regulations of the programme](#).
4. Make sure you can arrive to Hungary until the enrolment deadline of your study programme. In case of any problems, discuss the exact time of arrival with [your host institution](#). Please note that “The scholarship holder may request a permission to start his/her studies in a later semester exclusively because of health issues or unexpected reasons through no fault of his/her own but only in particularly justified cases. The written request must be sent to the SiH Unit of Tempus Public Foundation by 30<sup>th</sup> September at the latest.” (see [our regulation](#) about how to do it).
5. Download your University's official „**Letter of Acceptance**”.
6. Download your „**Letter of Award**” – only if you did not postpone your studies with 1 or 2 semesters.
7. Finally, with the „Letter of Award” and the „Letter of Acceptance” together, you can start your visa procedure!

## IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE SCHOLARSHIP:

### ***1. Accept your scholarship offer***

As the next step you have to accept your scholarship in the DreamApply online application system (<https://apply.scyp.hu/>) until 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT YOUR SCHOLARSHIP UNTIL THE GIVEN DEADLINE, YOU WILL AUTOMATICALLY LOSE YOUR SCHOLARSHIP FOR THIS APPLICATION ROUND.

You will see the following at the top of the screen:

„You have received 1 reply.

Make or edit your final decision.”

After you click on it, you will be able to accept the scholarship in 3 steps.

Let us call your attention to the fact that you can only consider one study programme for decision: the one where you see Scholarship awarded. Please note that there is only one scholarship place offered for each applicant.

### ***2. Receive your Letter of Acceptance from your host institution***

Soon after accepting your scholarship offer, your host University will send you an official document through the online application system confirming that the University is ready to accept you as their student.

Your host University will also contact you about further details (such as accommodation, details and deadline of institutional enrolment). If you have any problems about these institution-related issues, you can also contact your [institutional Scholarship for Christian Young People coordinator](#).

### ***3. Receive your Letter of Award***

After you accepted the scholarship offer and got your Letter of Acceptance from your University, you can get your official Letter of Award from Tempus Public Foundation. Please keep this file downloaded on your computer as you will also need it for other official procedures later on, after your arrival to Hungary.

### ***4. Think about your date of arrival***

You need to arrive until the enrolment deadline of the study programme you will start. Scholarship holders need to be at least 18 years old (except for dance and art programmes) at the date of enrolment to the University.

### ***5. Start your visa procedure at your local Hungarian Consulate***

With your Letter of Award and your Letter of Acceptance, you can start your visa procedure at your local Hungarian Consulate/Embassy. Please, remember to start this process in time because officially, it may take 30 days until a visa is issued.

## IF YOU HAVE A “CONDITIONAL” STATUS:

If you have not submitted your language or study certificate(s), your passport copy or your medical certificate, you have to upload these documents to the online application system **until 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019 the latest**. Documents uploaded after the deadline will not be considered.

Parallel to this you are also required to ACCEPT YOUR SCHOLARSHIP UNTIL 11<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST.

The uploaded documents are checked by the Universities and if they are accepted, you will be able to download your Letter of Acceptance and your Letter of Award.
