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PART I: GENERAL INFORMATION

DESCRIPTION OF TOWN

- SHORT HISTORY AND LOCATION

Eger is a charming, well-preserved baroque city situated in the north-east of Hungary, in an area of great natural beauty. It is the educational and administrative centre of the region. Besides its historical heritage and architecture, Eger is best known for its thermal baths, medicinal waters, wines and culinary masterpieces. Its numerous educational institutions offer valuable learning experiences and are designed to meet the demands of both domestic and international students, including an inclusive and supportive atmosphere, beautiful surroundings and a vibrant cultural life. The city is also the centre of a wine growing region, and has gained a real reputation for producing wonderful wines, most notably the 'Bikavér' (Bull's Blood) and 'Egri Csillag' (Star of Eger). Eger is well-known for its multi-faceted history. The city is most famous for the siege of 1552, when only 2,000 men, women and children successfully defended the town from two Ottoman armies. Today, evidence of Eger's eventful past can still be witnessed throughout the town in the form of its baroque architecture and reminders of the Ottoman occupation in the shape of the Minaret and the Turkish baths. Another architectural masterpiece of the city is the main building of the University, the Lyceum. It was built in the 18th century and bears witness to the work of skilled craftsmen and architects from the whole of central europe. Eger has a lot to offer to culture-loving audiences, too. Although weekdays are quiet

and peaceful, culture and entertainment are baked into the fabric of the city. Eger is home to festivals all year round, hosting plenty of joyous events including the annual Baroque Festival, Castle Festival, Harvest Festival and numerous wine festivals, offering rich and diverse cultural experiences for the residents and visitors. Besides the major sights of interest, the historical city centre has many small shops and stores, a grocery market and a shopping mall – all within walking distance. You can reach the more distant parts of the city by bus, as services are efficient, frequent and inexpensive. There are also electric scooters and bikes at your disposal.

- MAIN LOCAL/CULTURAL EVENTS

Some dates for the summer programmes are not yet available, but the planned events for the course period are as follows: Eger Wine Festival (10-12th July 2025), concerts, Agria Summer Theatre Festival and the Frontier Castle Festival. Eger Wine Festival is one of the most joyous summer events of the city, held in the Archbishop's Garden, the green heart of Eger. Visitors gather there to listen to a series of concerts and drink excellent wines in a wonderful environment. Creatively composed, delicious meals are also offered by the best chefs of the region to create a true wine festival atmosphere. Agria Summer Theatre Festival offers numerous open-air theatre performances to present and promote our cultural heritage in and outside Hungary. During the Frontier Castle Festival visitors experience the great moments of the glorious siege of 1552, with authentic weapon demonstrations, historical re-enactment groups, knight trials, horseman show, parades, exhibitions and concerts. The artisans of traditional crafts offer their products, and warriors demonstrate their professional skills. Hungarian film club and folk dance training: EKCU staff will organise a film screening and folk dance event for participants to learn more about Hungarian culture.

- HOW TO REACH TOWN (LINKS FROM THE NEAREST AIRPORT, TRAIN OR COACH STATIONS)

The two nearest airports are in Budapest and Debrecen. Eger is connected to both cities and the rest of the country by an extensive rail and bus network, which is efficient, frequent and inexpensive. Coaches are clean, modern and are equipped with wi-fi. They leave for Eger from Puskás Ferenc Stadion, which is easily accessible from the M2 (red) metro line. There are two coaches to Eger every hour, one at quarter past the hour and the other at quarter to. The former is an 'express' service (expressz in Hungarian) which takes 100 minutes, and the latter goes via the town of Gyöngyös adding another 35 minutes onto the journey. You can get your ticket online or from the bus driver in cash. - By coach from Debrecen - Debrecen coach station is easily accessible by shuttle buses. Coaches leave for eger in every 2 hours. - By train from Budapest - Direct trains to eger run every hour and leave from Keleti Train Station Budapest (Keleti Pályaudvar) which can be reached by the M2 and M4 metro lines. Tickets can be purchased online or at the railway station. - By train from Debrecen - Direct trains to Eger run in every 2 hours and leave from Nagyállomás Railway Station, which can be reached by airport shuttle buses.

- Eger Wine Festival (10-12 July, 2025) is a festival that offers a lot more than just wines, as visitors can indulge in a unique and complex experience with music, arts and gastronomy. Eger Wine Festival has become one of the cornerstones of Eger Summer Events in Archbishop's Garden, Eger's biggest park. - Open-air concerts (in the Lyceum, Eger castle, Archbishop's garden and Dobó square) - Folk music and folk dance programmes: fostering traditions in eger is very important and one of the most important areas of it is folk music and folk dance, e.g. album Pimasz (Impudent) by the local Kerekes band was one of the top 10 world music albums in 2006. Csík band is one of the most popular folk art formations, the violinist of the band, Attila Szabó is a resident of Eger. The band received the Kossuth-prize, the most prestigious art award in 2013. Flóra Herczeg was discovered in a national talent-scouting contest. She started as a folksong singer but now she sings in musicals and rock operas as well as in her own band. Gajdos band having existed for 25 years promotes beauty and eternal values of Hungarian folk music. Chindren's dance-houses of Nyírettyűs and Tekergő bands are very popular in the town. Ethnofil band was formed from young people of Eger, taking their audience into the world of Hungarian folk music, world music, ethno funk and jazz. There are several groups working in the area of folkdance: László Lajtha folkdance group, Egres folkdance group, and Szederinda folkdance group. There is an open-air theatre festival during the summer period in Eger with many plays, musicals on show, and also a number of indoor and open-air cinema programmes.

LANGUAGE COMPONENT

- SHORT DESCRIPTION OF LANGUAGE COMPONENT: OBJECTIVES AND TEACHING METHODS

The course aims at helping learners to achieve an overall Hungarian language competence of level A1, developing "generative language use" to interact in a simple way and ask and answer simple questions. The objective of the 2-week course is to develop participants' language skills to: 1. Read and understand basic expressions and short, simple texts. 2. Engage in simple oral communications in order to provide and obtain essential information, using appropriate pronunciation. 3. Write basic, simple sentences leading to a paragraph. 4. Demonstrate limited control of essential grammatical structures. Teachers will use the University's own coursebbok to support the learning process as well as visual learning tools, such as pictures, symbols and short videos. As for the teaching methods, our teachers will mainly apply the Communicative Approach combined with the Direct Method. The former focuses on enabling the learners to communicate effectively and appropriately in the various situations they would be likely to find themselves in. In Direct Method the teaching is done entirely in the target language. Learners are not allowed to use their mother tongue and the focus is on developing language skills.

CULTURAL COMPONENT

- SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE CULTURAL COMPONENT: OBJECTIVES AND TEACHING METHODS

The objective of the Wine Culture and Wine Gastronomy Summer University is to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of Hungarian wine culture, focusing on the historical and cultural significance of the Eger Wine Region. By combining academic learning with experiential activities, the course aims to educate on Viticulture and Oenology, showcase regional wine diversity and practices and promote cultural immersion. It will also contribute to fostering a global appreciation of Hungarian wine. Eger Wine Region, with its centuries-old traditions, the variety of grapes and wines produced on the unique soil structure, and its presence in Hungarian literature, is one of the most suitable areas for the organisation of a summer university. It has all the facilities, both in terms of professional attractions and human resources, to offer a high quality course. The Institute of Viticulture and Oenology, which is part of EKCU, and its university vineyards and winery have the necessary infrastructure and cellar capacity for wine production. Besides that, participants will explore the nearby wineries as well as the Mátra Wine Region. Participants will also be encouraged to take part in the cultural programmes of the Eger Wine Festival, which takes place from 8 to 10 July 2025. Out-of class and extracurricular activities will also be organised, such as a sightseeing tour of the city of Eger, a day trip along with short visits to traditional wine cellars and cave dwellings, a rural farm or winery, and a nearby spa, to allow participants to fully immerse themselves in Hungarian culture. The study of Hungarian wine culture during classes and extracurricular activities will allow participants to gain a complete picture of Hungary and its winemaking traditions.
