PART I: GENERAL INFORMATION

DESCRIPTION OF TOWN

- SHORT HISTORY AND LOCATION

Debrecen is the second largest city in Hungary, the scientific and cultural centre of the eastern part of the country, a town of festivals. The city has over 200 thousand inhabitants. It lies in the north-eastern part of the Great Hungarian Plain 220 km from the capital city, Budapest, at the same longitude as the Finnish town Turku and the Norwegian Hammerfest, and at the same distance from the Equator as Graz, Basel, Dijon and Seattle. Thousands of visitors seeking treatment or recreation take advantage of the city's health spa. Its university has over 25 thousand students. The city's cultural programmes, festivals and the Summer School's courses are attended by several hundred thousand people every year. Throughout its history Debrecen has always been the centre of trade and played a significant role in Hungarian academia. It has always been a crossroads between North and South, East and West.

- MAIN LOCAL/CULTURAL EVENTS

Debrecen has a great number of cultural festivals all through the year. Debrecen Open-air theatre operates in July-August, and popular summer events include the Campus Festival and Young

Musicians' Summer Academy in July, the biennial Béla Bartók International Choir Competition in July-August, Debrecen Wine Fest and Debrecen Flower Parade in August. Debrecen will be the one of the venues of the 2024 European University Games also in July.

- HOW TO REACH TOWN (LINKS FROM THE NEAREST AIRPORT, TRAIN OR COACH STATIONS)

From Budapest, Debrecen can be reached in several ways: By train: Intercity trains from Budapest to Debrecen leave from Budapest Keleti (Eastern) Railway Station and Nyugati (Western) Railway Station (destination: Debrecen, Nyíregyháza or Záhony). Seat reservation is compulsory on ICs (timetables can be checked at www.mavcsoport.hu). The journey takes approximately two hours and 45 minutes. Take tram No. 1 at Debrecen railway station and travel to the stop called Egyetem. By car: Take motorways M3 and m35 (a toll must be paid at petrol stations in advance). It takes about 2 and a half hours to get to Debrecen. Exit at Debrecen Észak. You can also take highway No. 4 from Budapest (220 km). The journey takes approx. 4 hours. By air: Debrecen can be reached by plane from several European cities such as London, Eindhoven, Rome etc.

- TRANSPORT IN TOWN (BRIEF INFORMATION ON THE MAIN MEANS OF TRANSPORT AVAILABLE)

The best means of transport is tram no. 1 running from the railway station across the city centre to the campus of the University of Debrecen where the language classes and a significant part of the cultural events take place. Buses also run regularly, covering parts of the city that cannot be easily approached by tram.

SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANISING INSTITUTION

Unique among Hungary's similar language institutions, Debrecen Summer School draws upon a great and long-standing tradition. Established in 1927, it has grown to become the biggest Hungarian summer school. Each year hundreds of students from 30-40 countries are taught by a team of about 20-30 experienced instructors from the University of Debrecen and various schools in the city. Debrecen Summer School specializes in teaching Hungarian as a foreign language and diffusing knowledge of Hungarian culture. Its mission is to help its students pursue specific aspects of the Hungarian language and culture in depth. Disseminating the cultural values of any given nation is an inalienable part of teaching that nation's language. Consequently, the cultural programs offered as part of Debrecen Summer School's courses greatly contribute to the success of the primary task, which is teaching Hungarian. That is why most of our courses include events which serve to provide entertainment value as well as information about Hungarian culture and also opportunities to study the language in an informal way. Exploiting its unique position, DSS aims at taking an increasing role in the training of university students who pursue a career in teaching Hungarian as a foreign language. In accordance with an agreement with Károli Gáspár University of the Reformed Church, would-be teachers studying at that institution can do training practice at DSS's courses as of 2011. The purpose of the training practice is to provide trainees with practical teaching skills (e.g. lesson preparation and planning, classroom management, teacher's roles, surveys, and research). It also includes presenting a deeper knowledge of the field of education (e.g. school life and management) as well as efforts to train students in the assessment, development, and research of the learning

process so that they can perform more efficiently in their future jobs.

ACCOMMODATION

Students will stay in Andaházy Dormitory which is about a 15-minute walk from the university campus. The dormitory located in a beautiful, quiet and green environment can accommodate 140 guests, mainly in modern and comfortable two-bedded rooms with bathrooms shared by two rooms and individual internet cable connection as well as Wi-Fi. In addition to well-equipped kitchens or dining-rooms as well as laundries with washing machines and driers, students can use a computer room, a gym and a nice garden. The rent for scholarship-holders in 2-bedded rooms is 0 EUR/two weeks/person but if they want to stay in a single room, they must pay 200 EUR/two weeks/person.

MEALS

During the summer courses students are offered buffet breakfast, lunch and dinner at the cafeteria on campus by meal tickets issued to them by Summer School. The canteen offers four different menus including a vegetarian option. Besides the canteen, eateries and restaurants can be found on campus within convenient distance.

We welcome students on the day of arrival at the Reception Desk of the Summer School which in 2024—due to the European University Games—will be located in the entrance hall of the University Church. The registration is preceded by sending out the official confirmation containing the basic information students need to get to Debrecen and to the office of the Summer School. On arrival, students are registered and they receive a Summer School folder containing all the necessary information they need during their stay in Debrecen. In addition, the daily programmes of each course are available on the School's website and in the form of downloadable QR codes. The organizers of the Summer School are available round the clock in case students need assistance.

EXTRAMURAL ACTIVITIES

- SITE VISITS

Sightseeing in Debrecen with Hungarian and English guides. Setting off from the main building of the

university, students visit the most significant sights of the city: the Déri Museum; Kossuth Square with the Great Reformed Church: a major building in Hungarian Protestantism and a historic site; the Small Reformed Church. An all-day excursion is offered on the first and third Saturdays to different parts of the country, e.g. Hajdúszoboszló, Hortobágy, Nyíregyháza, Tokaj, Eger or Zsáka, etc. The concrete venues usually change every year. During the tours students can learn about Hungary's history and culture at large.

The aim of the beginner course is to train and prepare students for the use and understanding of the basics of Hungarian in everyday situations. It amounts to the following with regard to linguistic skills and competences: Listening skills: The learner understands basic words and expressions referring to him/herself, his/her immediate environment and communication partner. S/he can decode short sentences if they are articulated carefully and at a slow pace. Reading skills: The learner understands the most basic words and phrases and simple sentences in relation to certain topics: e.g. introductions, living space, immediate environment. Speaking skills: The learner is capable of taking part in very simple communicative situations: introductions, shopping, saying where he lives, asking for food or drink. S/he understands slow, careful speech in interactions involving basic vocabulary. S/he can produce simple texts of a few sentences about himself. Writing skills: The learner can compose a short text about himself. S/he can fill out simple forms with his details, e.g. check-in forms at a hotel. The language-teaching methodology employed by DSS focuses on communicative competence. At the same time, it does not ignore the development of grammatical and lexical competences either. Serving the same purpose, the core teaching sources used at the courses (the Hungarolingua series designed at DSS) offer a modular curriculum. The intensive nature of these short courses necessitates the presence of a mediating language in the classroom. This language is usually English.

- SHORT DESCRIPTION OF LANGUAGE ELEMENTS INCLUDED IN THE COURSE: OBJECTIVES AND TEACHING METHODS

The academic course on Modern Hungary is offered for foreigners who are interested in the history and culture, the past and the present of Hungary but whose level of Hungarian is not yet enough to immerse in the topic. The course has been designed with special regard to those who (might) get into contact with Hungary or Central Europe. Based on the major turning points of the history of our country in the 19th-20th centuries, Modern Hungary provides a comprehensive portrait of the political and cultural events as well as persons and institutions of nearly two centuries. The additional cultural programmes will provide an opportunity for the participants to visit places which are closely connected to the events and personalities discussed in the lectures and seminars. Major topics of the two-week course include: Hungary during the Napoleonic Wars; The Reform Age in Hungary; Calvinism and Enlightenment; Revolution, Oppression and Compromise; The Dual Monarchy; Hungarian Romantic Art and Literature; Hungary in the Great War; The First Generation of Nyugat; Hungarian Painting in the First Half of the 20th Century; Hungary in World War II; The Hungarian Jewry in the 19th and 20th Centuries; Hungary after 1945; Literature under Communism; Hungarian Literature and Film in the 20th Century.
