


# COMPREHENSIVE, CONTINUOUS PRACTICAL SUPPORT FOR THE INTERNATIONALIZATION OF HEIS


Number of international students (capita)






Increasing number of study programs in the framework of Stipendium Hungaricum Program


One-tier master programs
