Successful Partnership



Cooperation

Agreement for supporting Stipendium Hungaricum was signed by the Ministry of Human Capacity of Hungary and the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia on February 6, 2017 .

- ✓ The quota for Georgian citizens to study in Hungary – 80.
- ✓ The quota for Hungarian citizens to participate in summer schools in Georgia – 5.

The program is managed by:

- ✓ **The Tempus Public Foundation** from Hungarian side.
- ✓ **The LEPL International Educational Center** from Georgian side.

Results for 2017-2018 academic year

- ✓ **63 Georgian citizens** are financed for BA, MA, integrated MA and PhD Programs in Hungary.
- ✓ **3 Hungarian citizens** are financed for the summer school in Georgia offered by the Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University.



Good Practices Regarding the Promotion of the SH Scholarship Programme



The promotion aims at disseminating of information and increasing accessibility to the program.

1. Dissemination of information through:

- ✓ media: TV, radio
- ✓ on-line resources: facebook, web-page
- ✓ effective communication: e-mail, hotline

2. Working Meetings:

- ✓ Consultation meetings in the center,
- ✓ Orientation sessions in universities.

3. Ensuring high reliability of the program

- ✓ Well implemented double application and evaluation process
- ✓ Transparent selection process



Challenges



1. Synchronization of two application processes with SH/IEC;
2. Technical problems;
3. Unexpected extra requirements and exams by host universities to students;
4. Unequal distribution of grants (MA-61, PHD -4, BA-14, OPT-1);
5. Lack of promotion of study opportunities in Georgia for Hungarian students.
