In a school where values and roles remain constant and focus is placed on the positive aspects of learning, students will be more open to actively participating in class.

This should be a primary goal for all teachers, since lack of motivation is often the root of disciplinary issues and early school leaving.

This way, they get a new, more important roles in their community, as someone who is taking care of plants, who is teaching members of community how to grow plants and someone who contributes to community and creates better environment in their village.

- 1st grade students get welcome cards with their photo and text which contain rights, responsibilities and advices
- This is permanent memory of their first high school days
