The instruments of the various scholarship programs have an impact on the essential institutional pillars of internationalization of Hungarian HEIs.

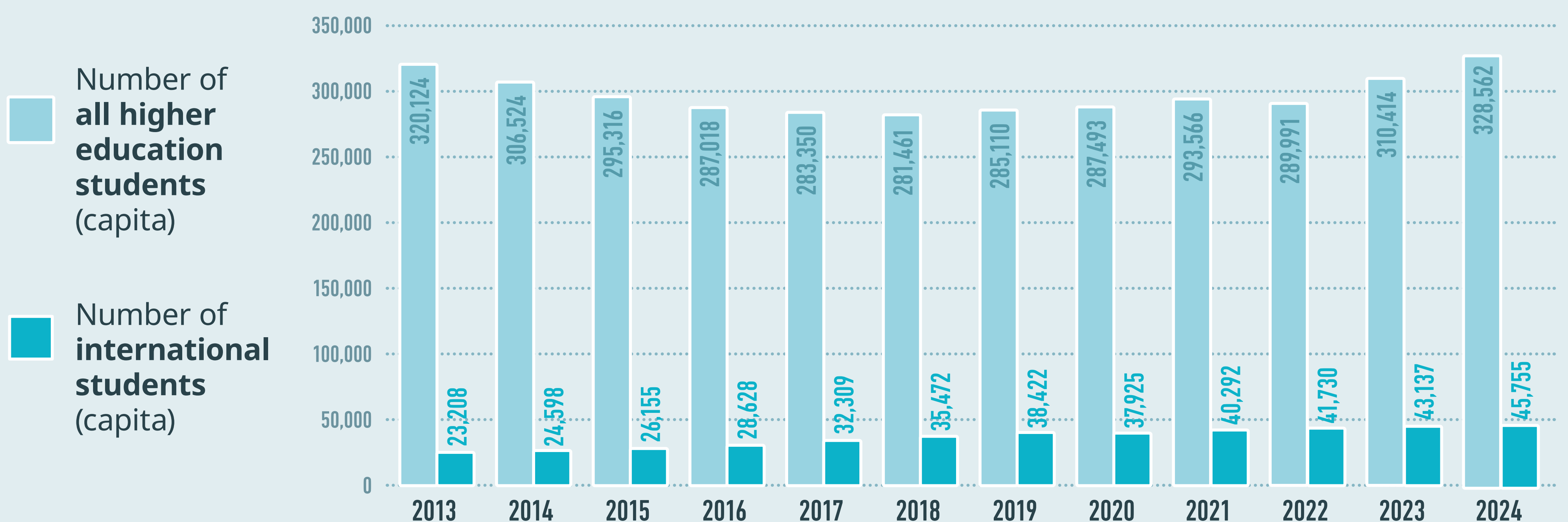

The program has had a significant impact on the number of self-financed students, increased the inbound degree mobility and that has been accompanied by factors such as the quality improvement of higher education.



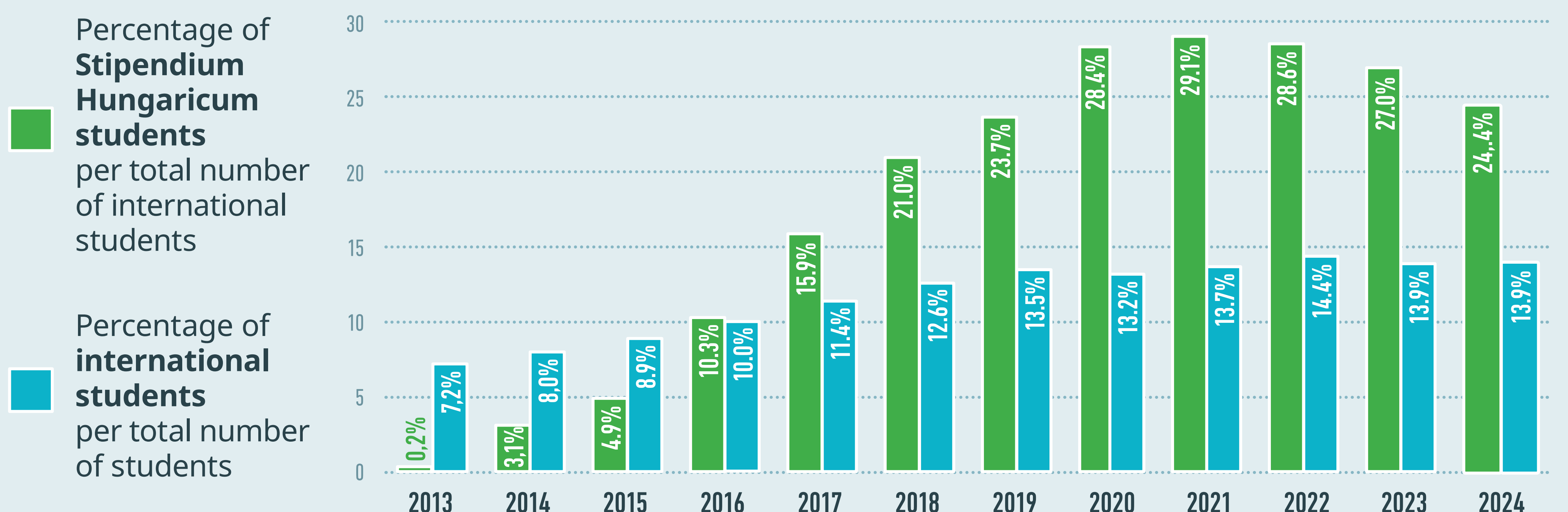
Trends in the number of higher education students in Hungary 2013–2024

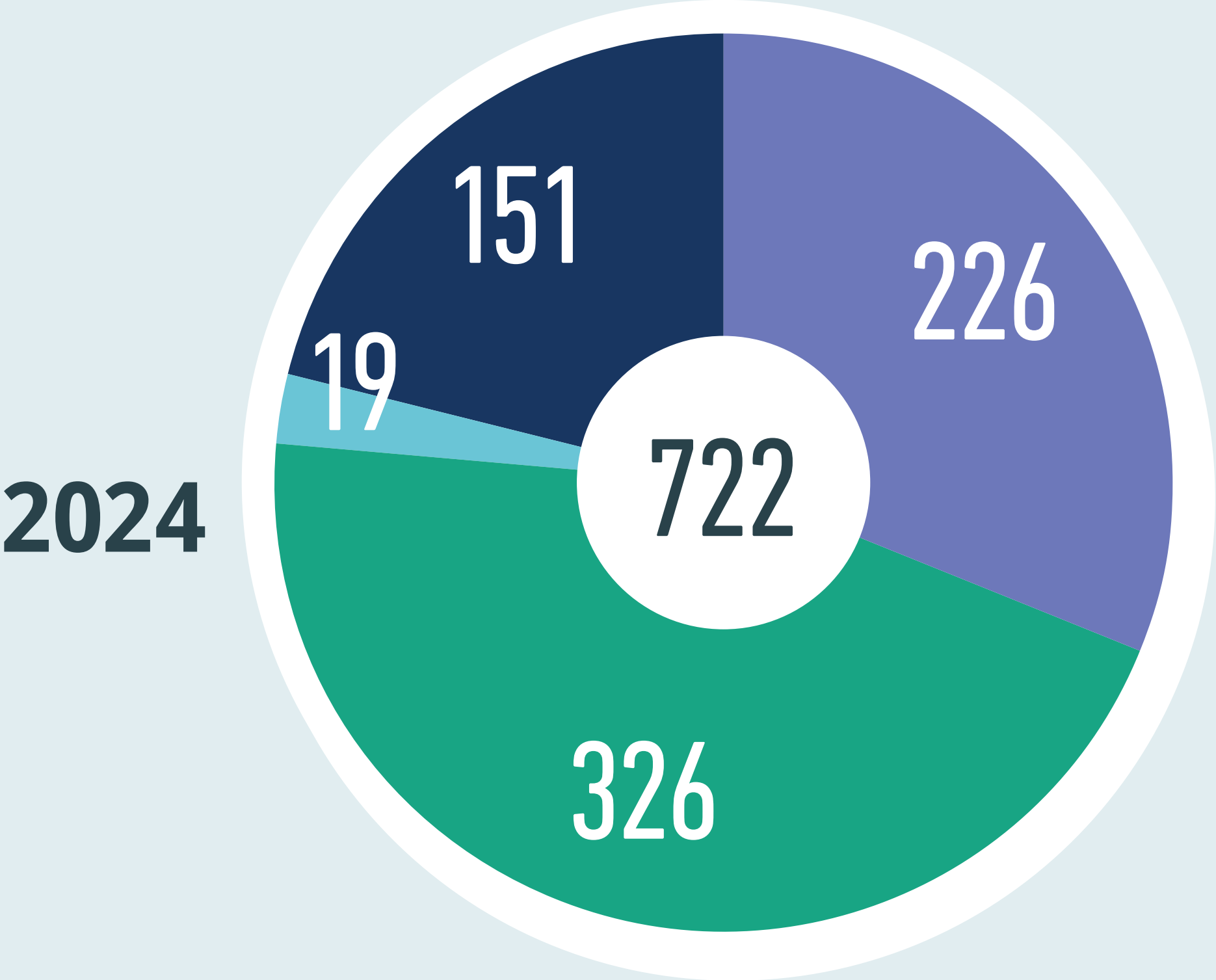
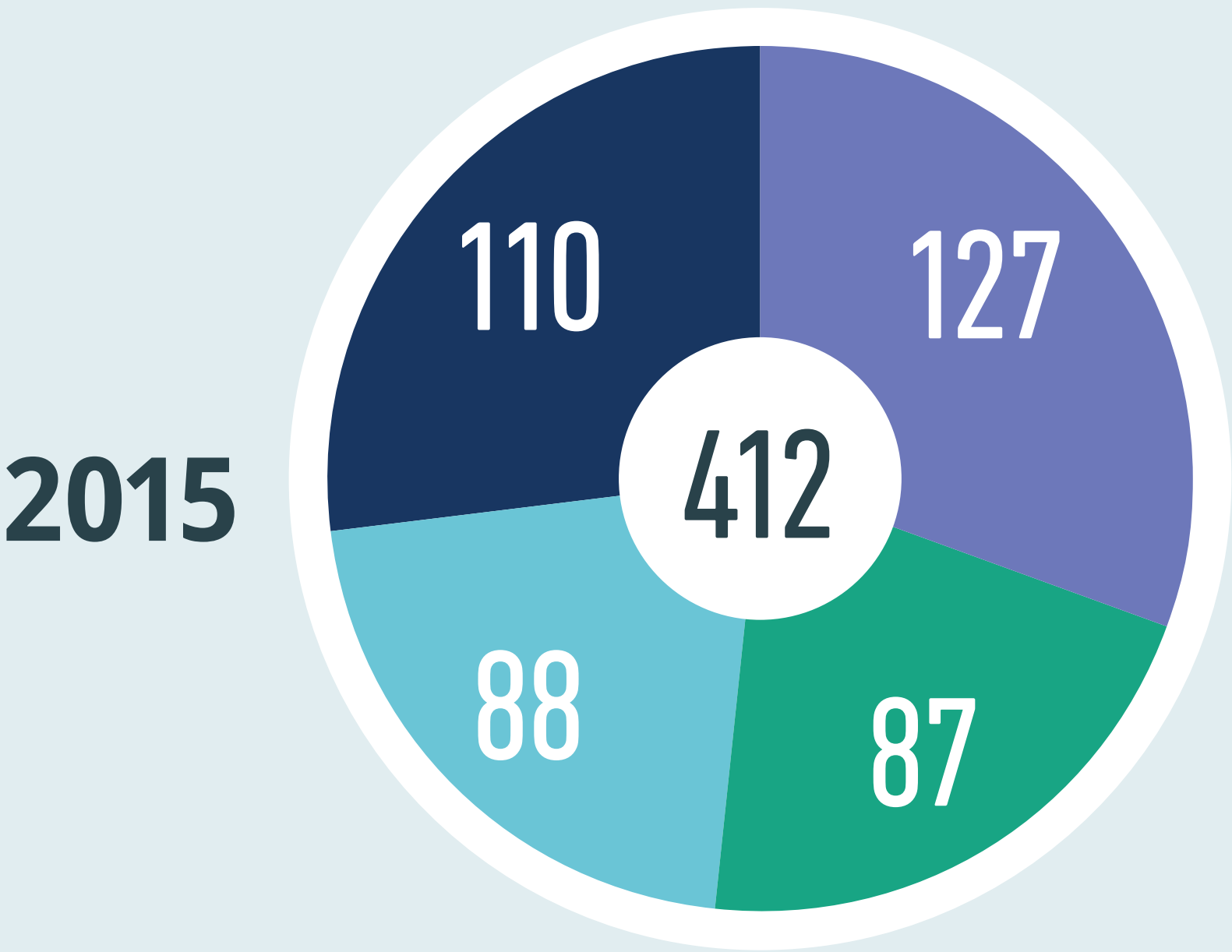
Share of international students and Stipendium Hungaricum students 2013–2024

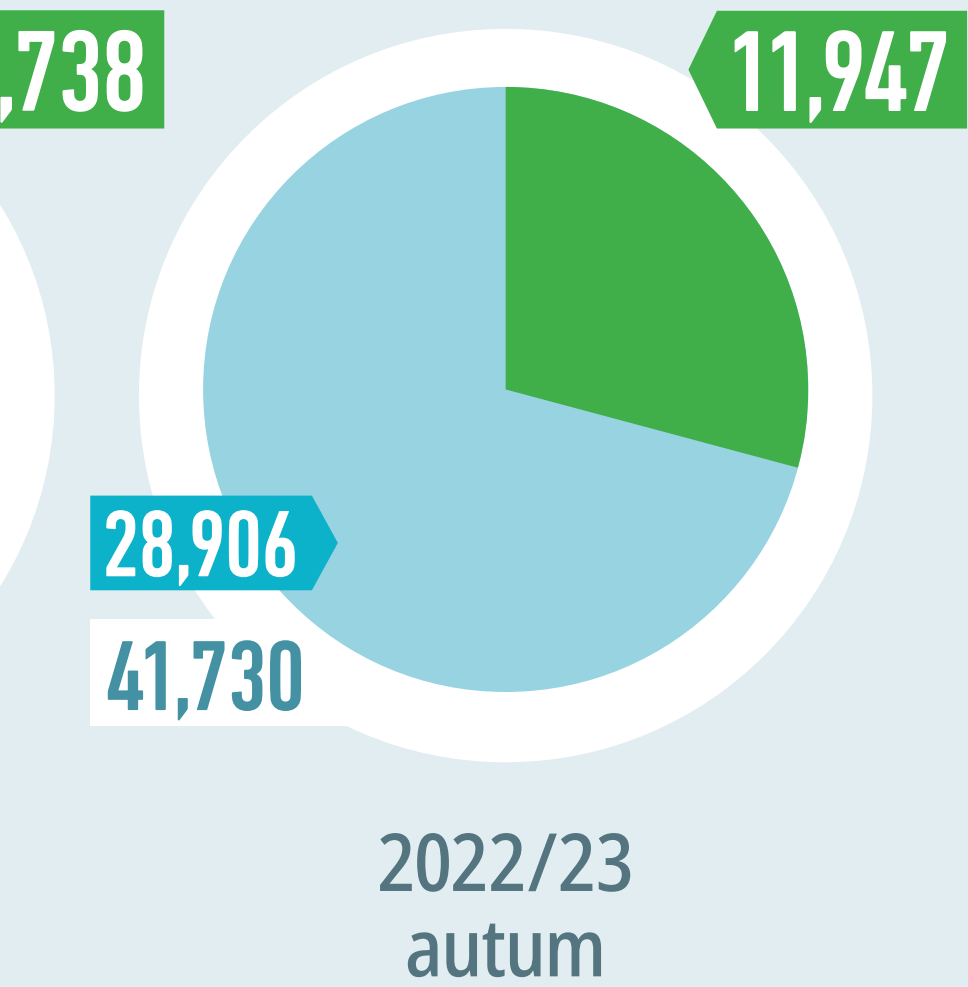
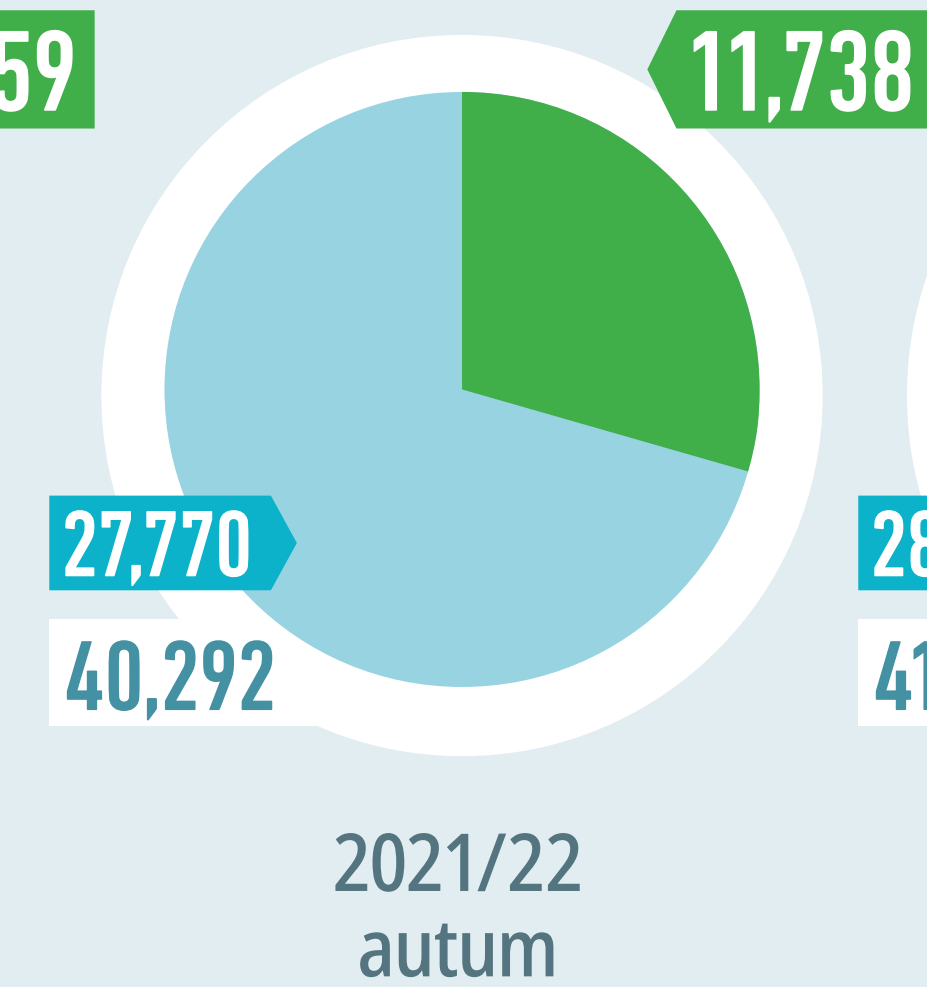
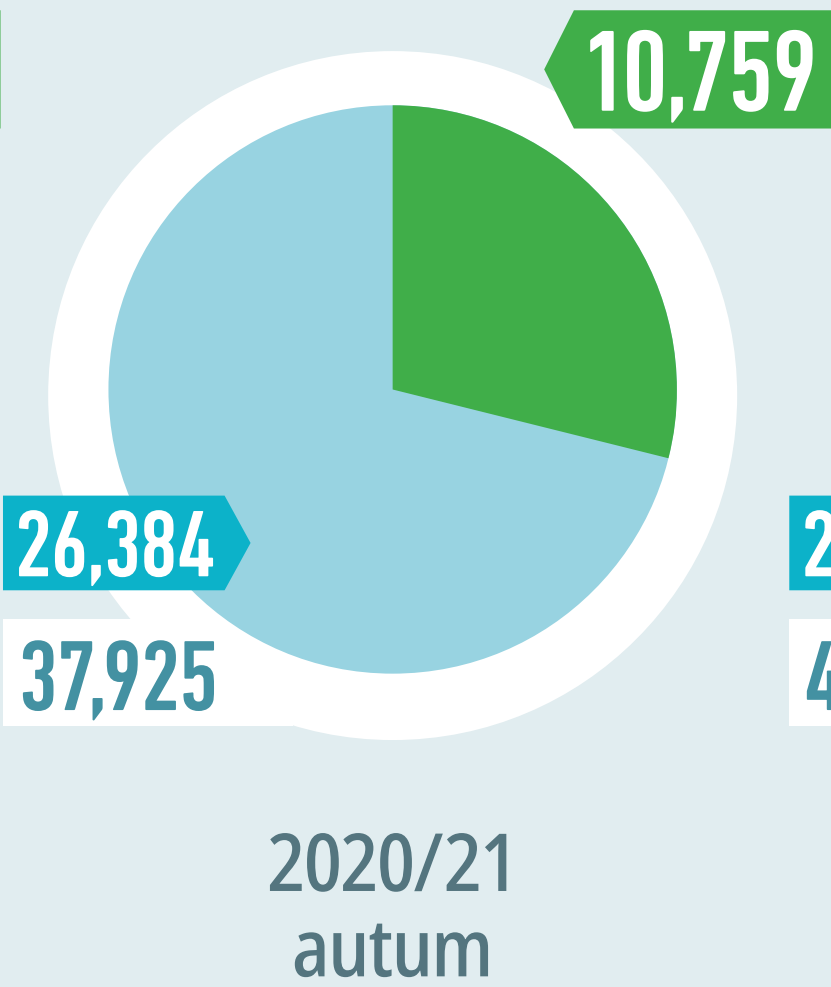
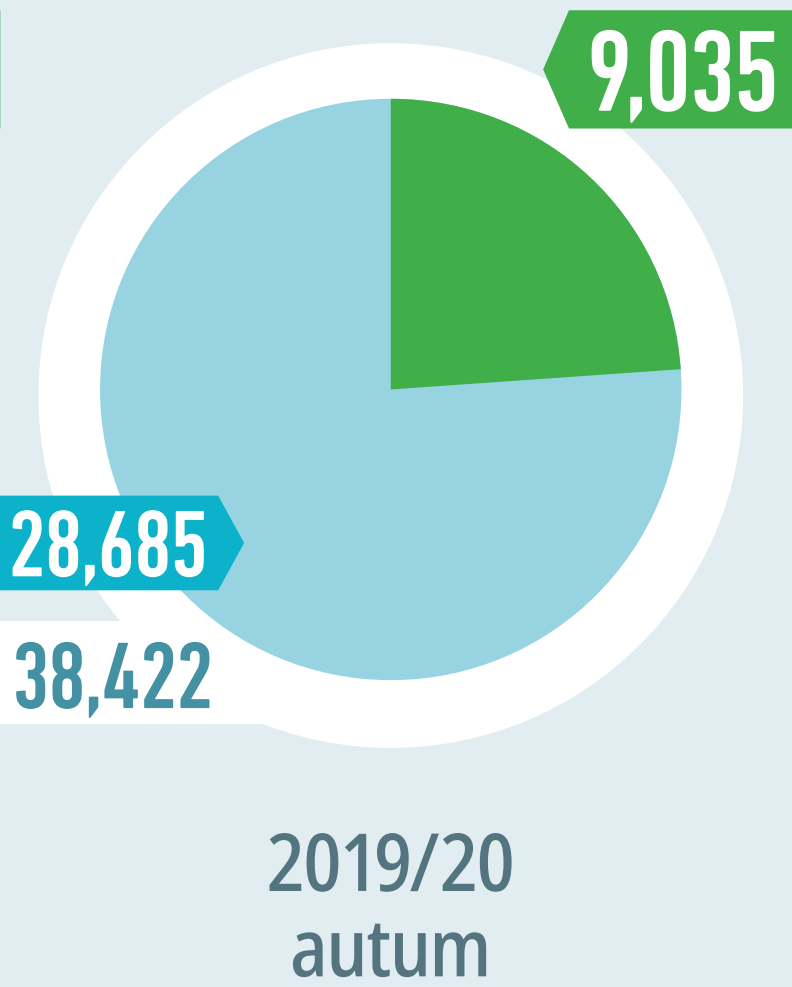
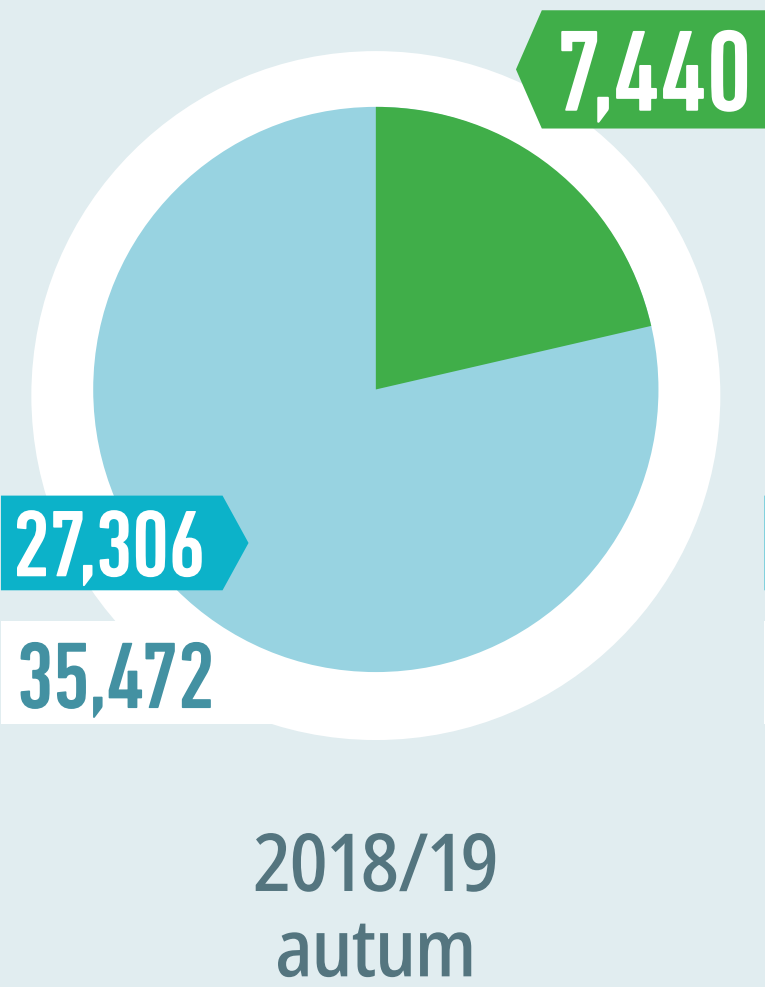
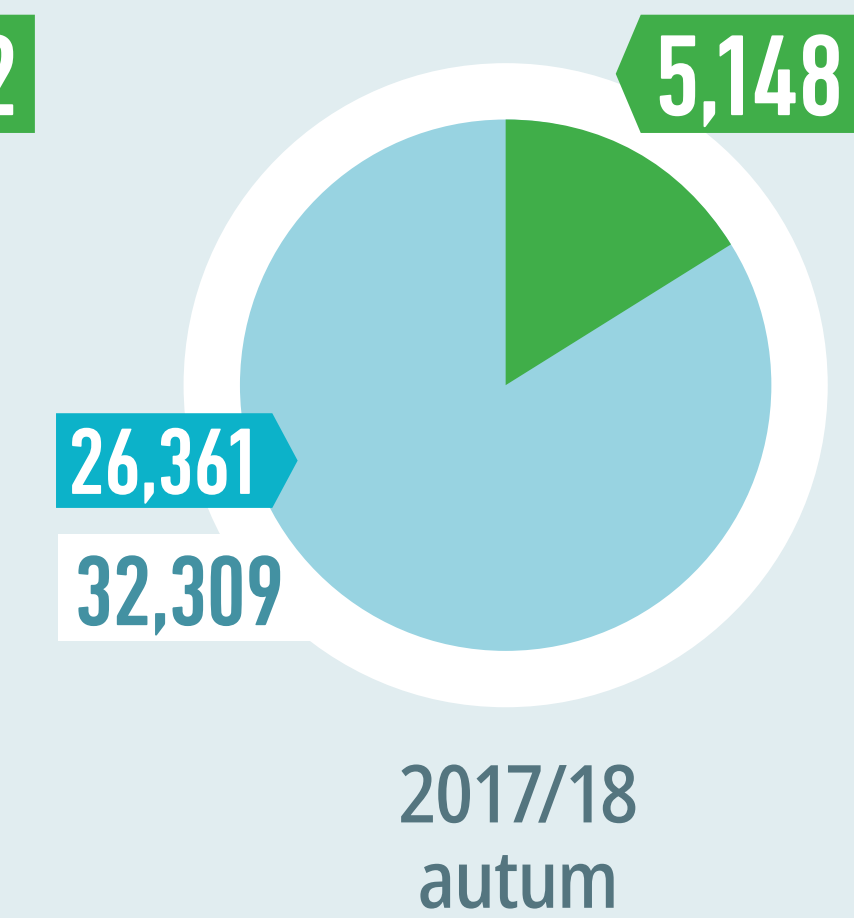
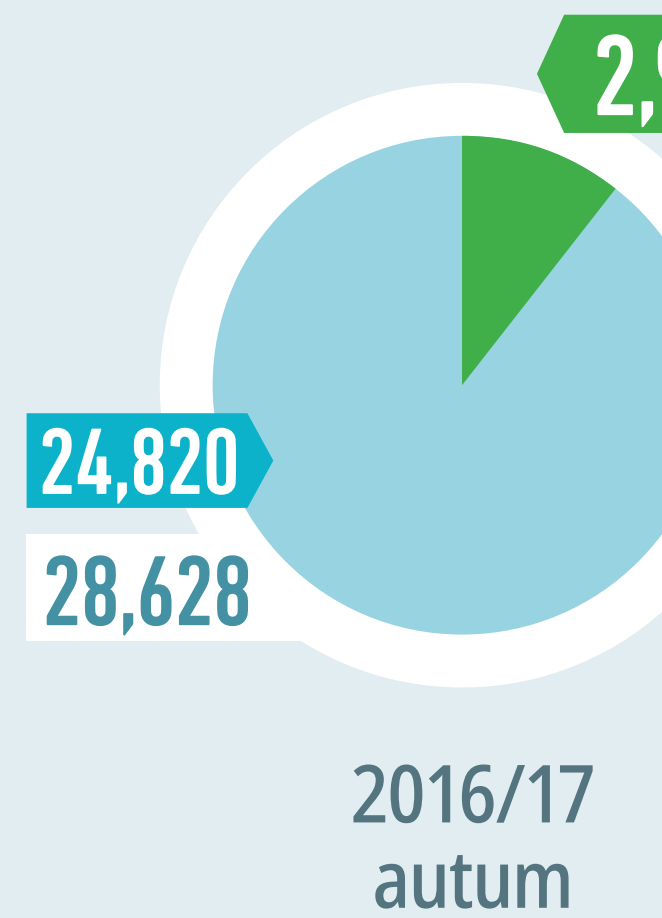
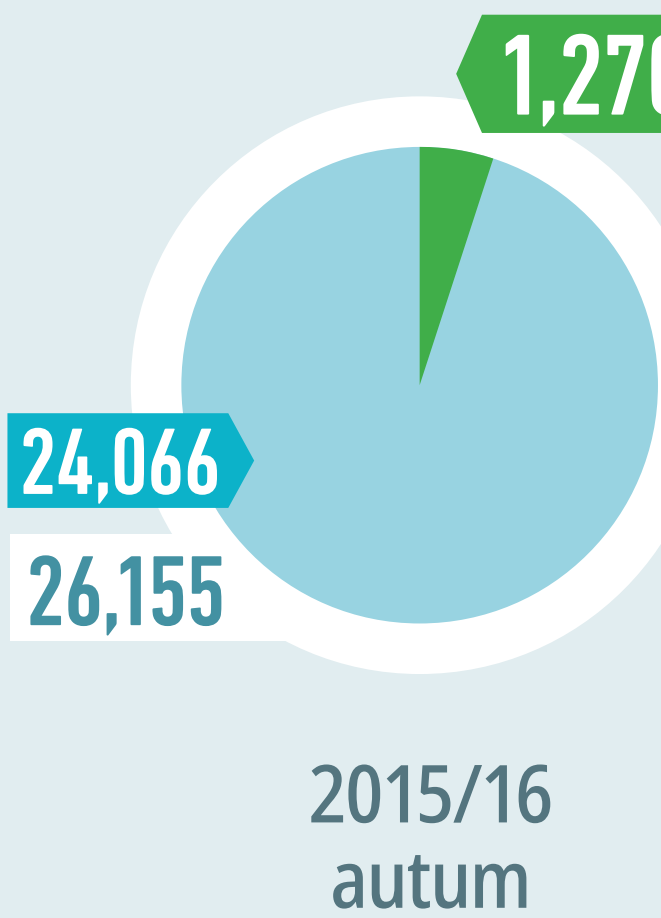
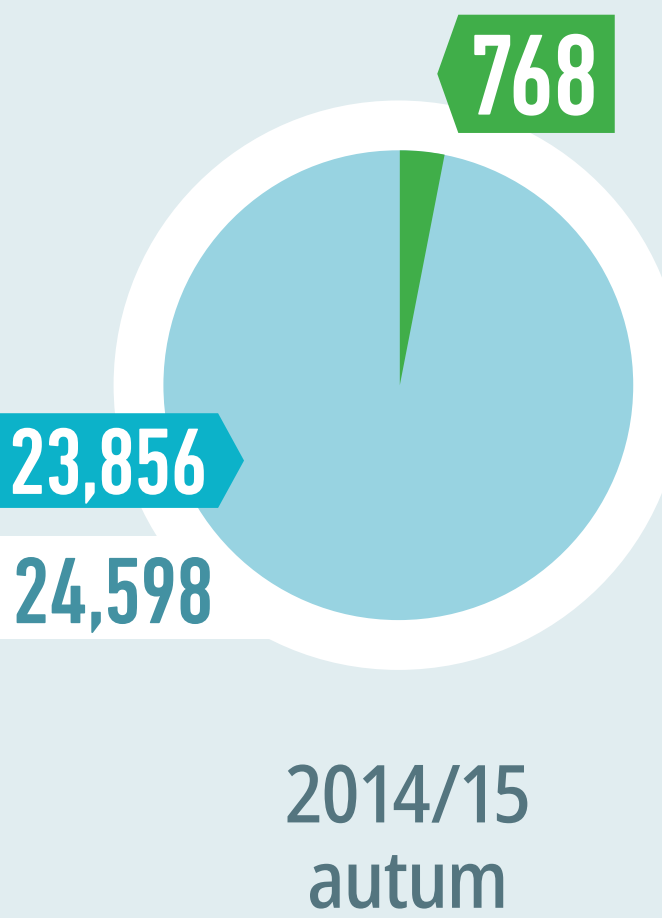
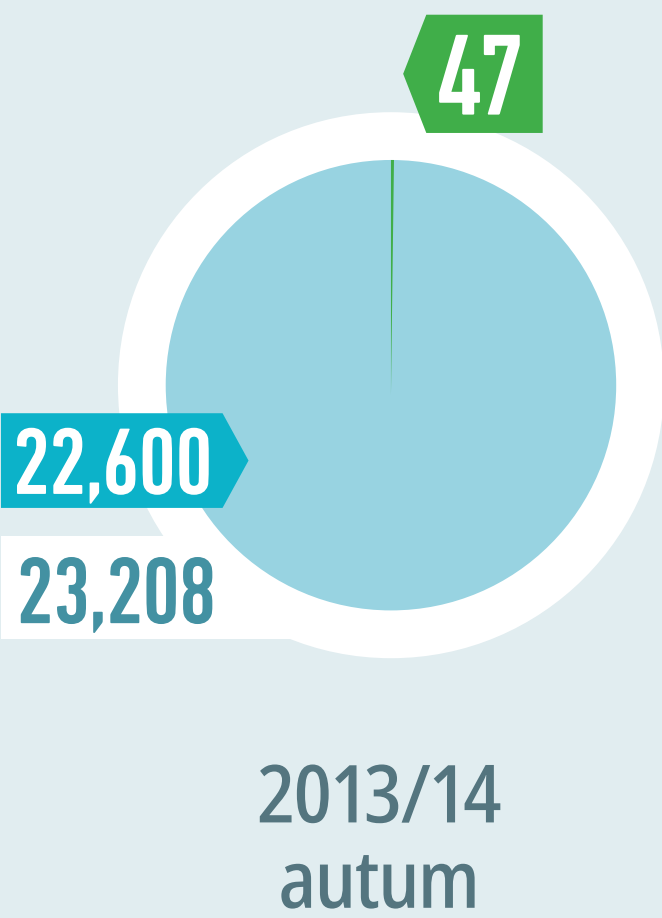

Number of international students (capita)

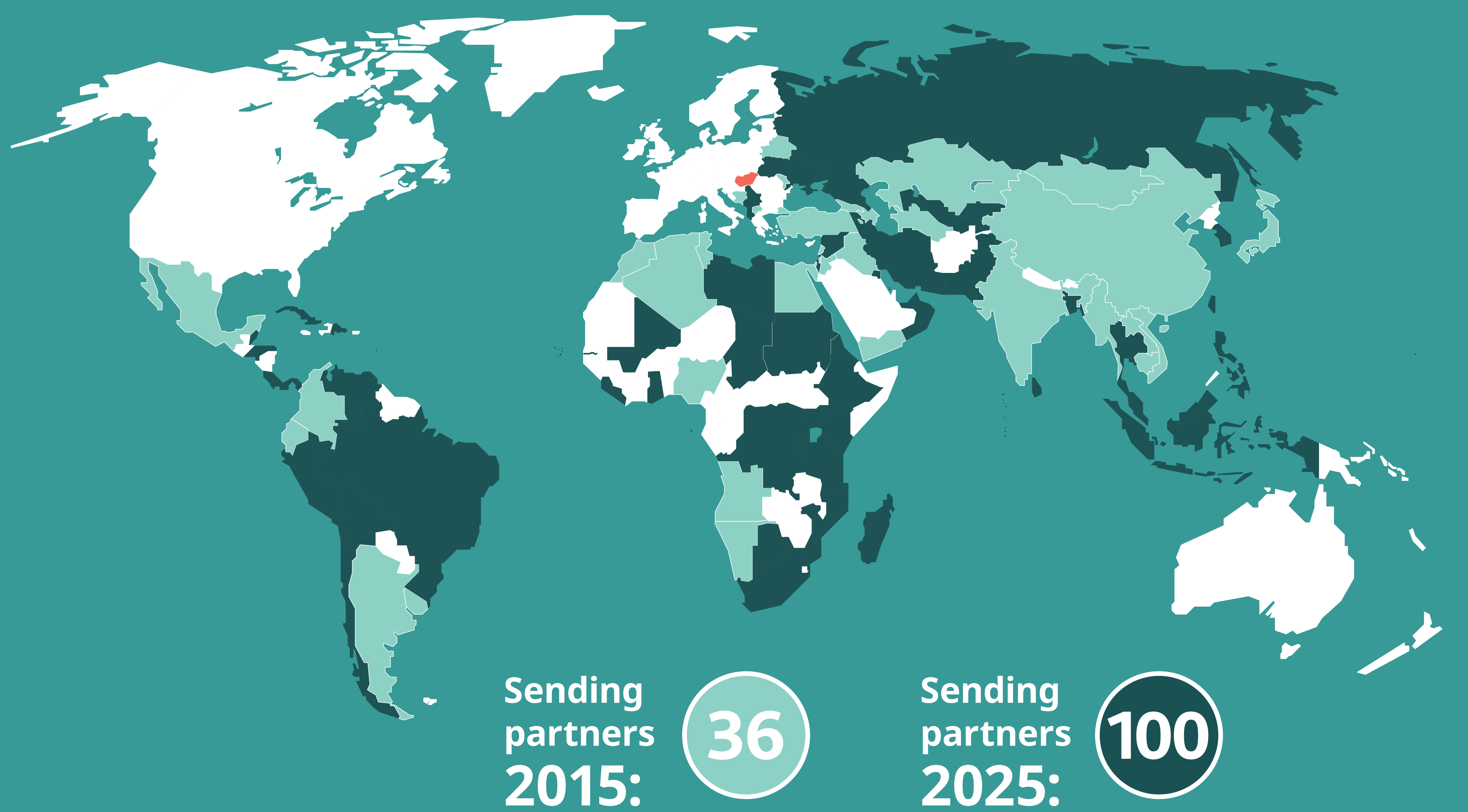
