

HOW CAN A LONG-TERM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFLUENCE MOBILITY TREND?


The instruments of the various scholarship programs have an impact on the essential institutional pillars of internationalization of Hungarian HEIs.

The poster presents long-term, data-based experience of the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Program, that was launched by the Hungarian Government in 2013 to promote the internationalization of Hungarian higher education and to attract international students from around the world.




The program has had a significant impact on the number of self-financed students, increased the inbound degree mobility and that has been accompanied by factors such as the quality improvement of higher education.

Share of international students and Stipendium Hungaricum students 2013–2024










Increasing number of study programs in the framework of Stipendium Source: Higher Education Information System




Number of international students, SH scholarship holders and self-financed students 2013–2023 Source: Higher Education Information System
