
BASIC REGIONAL DATA

Area 93 029 km²; Inhabitants 9.830.000 (Central Statistics Office, 2016)

Central Hungarian Region: Budapest + Pest county

6919 km²; Inhabitants 2.946.516 (2011)




LOCAL GOVERNMENT SYSTEM IN BUDAPEST

Budapest consists of **twenty-three** districts. The local government system of Budapest is unique: the city has a peculiar **dual self-government system**.

This means besides Budapest Municipality - the local government of Budapest - each of the twenty-three districts have their own government, the so-called district municipalities, with elected mayors and a body of

representatives.

Both the City and the Districts are local governments, **not subordinated to one another**, each having specific duties and powers, specified by law.



MUNICIPALITY OF BUDAPEST

The Municipality of Budapest is a legal entity, represented by the Mayor

Main decision making body: General Assembly of Budapest

- has 33 members, and the Mayor
- members are the 23 mayors of the districts and 9 representative from so called compensation party lists
- holds ordinary meetings at least six times a year, its meetings are open to the public

The Mayor's Office is a budgetary entity, main task is to implement the resolutions relating to public administration

- 10 departments
- 3 Deputy Mayor's Office
- Mayor's office

- 3 year (2017-2020) community driven R&I project
- People-Oriented Transport and Mobility approach
- Aims to implement a pilot program running at five urban and periurban areas:
 Hamburg, Oxfordshire, Trikala, Üsküdar and Budapest
- Citizens, city authorities and innovation experts work together as 'communities'
- Define the transport and mobility challenges that interest them, co-design ideas and concepts, put these concepts to the real test and then scale up those with more potential.



- Starting: May 2018
- Main objective: converting Budapest's specific neighbourhoods into smart and sustainable spaces
- Partners:

 - Local government of the 11th district of Budapest (Újbuda)
- Pilot area: György Goldmann Square, 11th district
