PURPOSE

They will also be participating in a workshop with analyses examples of good applications and in workshops of preparing applications considering their own ideas of possible projects while going through all phases of the project span.

The seminar is targeted to civil society organizations and public authorities from Austria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Luxembourg, Slovakia and Slovenia who are interested in developing international cooperation with funding from the Europe for Citizens Programme, including towns, municipalities and regional authorities, town twinning associations and networks, non-profit organizations and CSOs, survivor's associations, cultural/youth/educational/research organizations. One participant per organization is expected to attend (total number of participants is limited, expecting three participants per country). The working language of the seminar is English.
