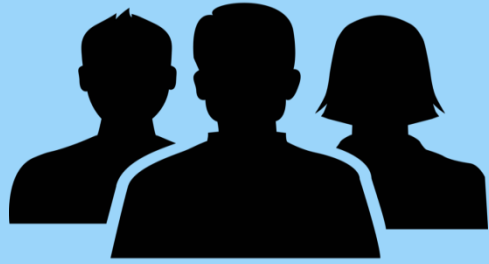

depending on the travel distance



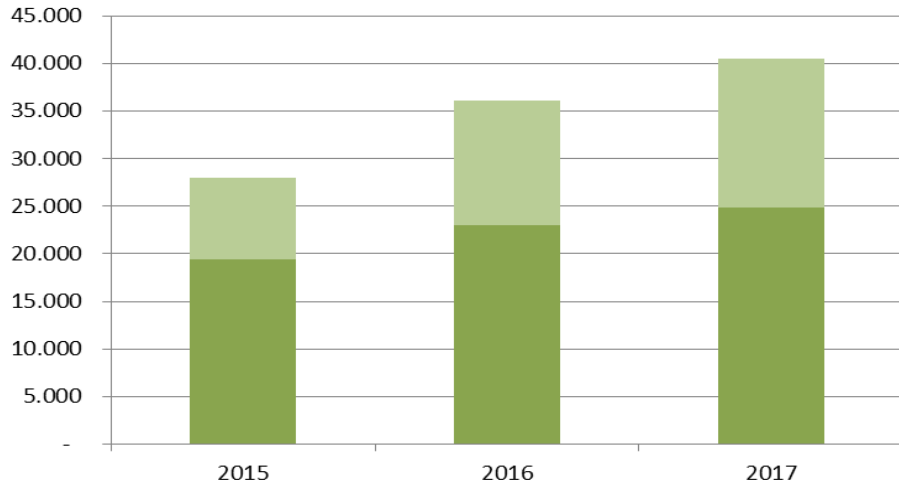

## Estimated number of funded mobilities

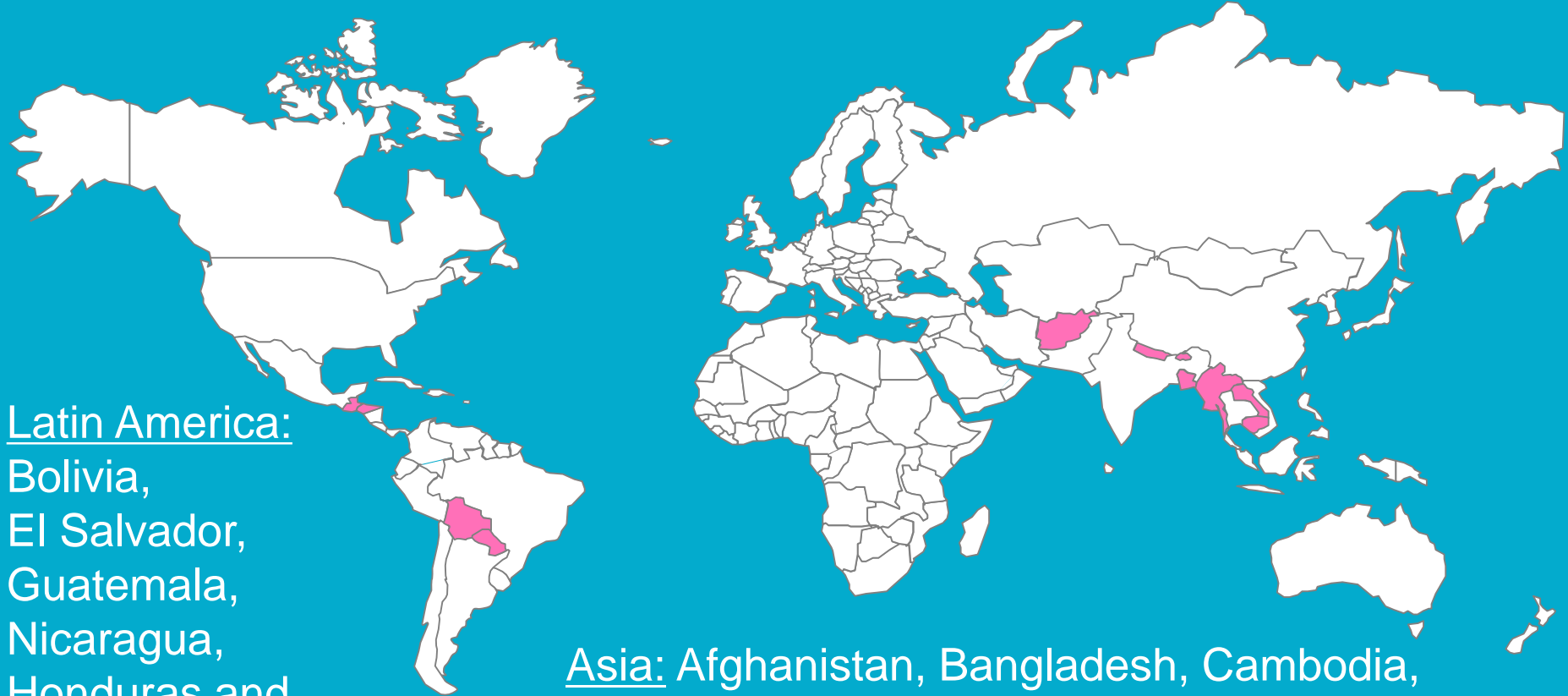

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## Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees in brief

- excellent Joint Master courses offered by **international consortia of HEIs** from Programme (& Partner) Countries
- **attract best students worldwide**  
(high-level scholarships, high level guest lectures)

- **350 Joint Master Degree courses** between 2014-2020
- fund **30,000 students and staff** over 7 years



## Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees: structure

- **integrated study programme**, fully recognised in the participating countries
- study period in at least **two** of the Programme Countries (represented in the consortium)
- length: **12, 18 or 24 months** (60, 90, 120 ECTS)
- **double, multiple or joint degree** at the end



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## EMJMD funding rules

**The EU grant for an EMJMD will be indicatively ~ 4 million €**

**HEIs:** Contribution to the consortium management costs (incl. costs for invited scholars and guest lecturers)

- 50.000 € per student intake (= 200.000 € in total) + 20.000 € for optional preparatory year
- Income from students' participation fees (paid by EC 4500-9000 EUR/year)

**Students:** max 25.000 € per academic year and per scholarship

Actual amount varies according to:

- \* EMJMD's length of studies (60, 90 or 120 ECTS credits)
- \* Student's country of residence
- \* EMJMD level of participation costs





## Joint Master Degrees: how to apply

- Annual Calls for Proposals issued by EU
- Next deadline: 15 February 2018 – 12:00 CET
- Apply direct to EACEA:

- Programme Country institutions may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium
- Proposals assessed by experts on basis of relevance, quality of design, quality of team, impact and dissemination
- About **45 EMJMD projects** are funded per year

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### 3. Capacity Building for Higher Education





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Well industrialised regions can not apply (PI America, PI Asia, etc.)

## Capacity Building in brief

Objectives: to build capacity and help modernise HEIs in Partner Countries, to ensure structural, long-lasting impact

- Support modernisation & internationalisation
- Improve quality
- Improve the level of competences & skills
- Enhance management, governance in HEIs
- Promote people-to-people contacts, intercultural understanding

Duration: **24-36 months**

Fund: **Min. 500,000 - Max. 1,000,000 €**



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## CBHE – Types of Projects

### Joint Projects:

=> Impact Institutions

curriculum development

university governance & management

Links between HE **institutions** and the wider economic and social environment

### Structural Projects:

=> Impact Systems

modernisation of policies, governance and management of higher education systems

Links between HE **systems** and the wider economic and social environment



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## Joint Projects – Examples of Activities

*development, testing and adapting of curricula, learning and teaching materials,*

*organisation of **staff training** (academic and non academic)*

***university-enterprise cooperation**, including the creation of business start-ups*

***modern university services** e.g. for financial management, international relations, student counselling and guidance, academic affairs and research*

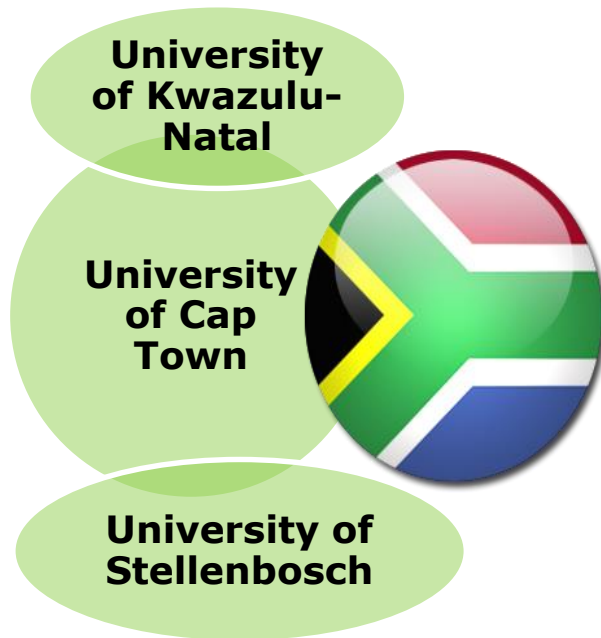
