

Duration of the project and activity

The duration of the project will be of 3 days exluding the day of arrival and the day of leaving. It will take part in a period between the 1° July 2017 and the 30° March 2018. In these days will be performed the following activities:

- Conference on the "Functioning of the European Justice and its governance bodies", with the help of multimedial tools.
- 2. Conference: "The form of legal protection in the European Union for the eruopean citizenship".
- 3. Theatre performance "Allegory of the European Cort".
- 4. Workshops with max 30 people.
- 5. Creation of a an advertising material about European Justice that will be share on the web.
- 6. Questionnaire before and after the conferences.
- 7. Social activities and field trips during the afternoon of the 3 days
